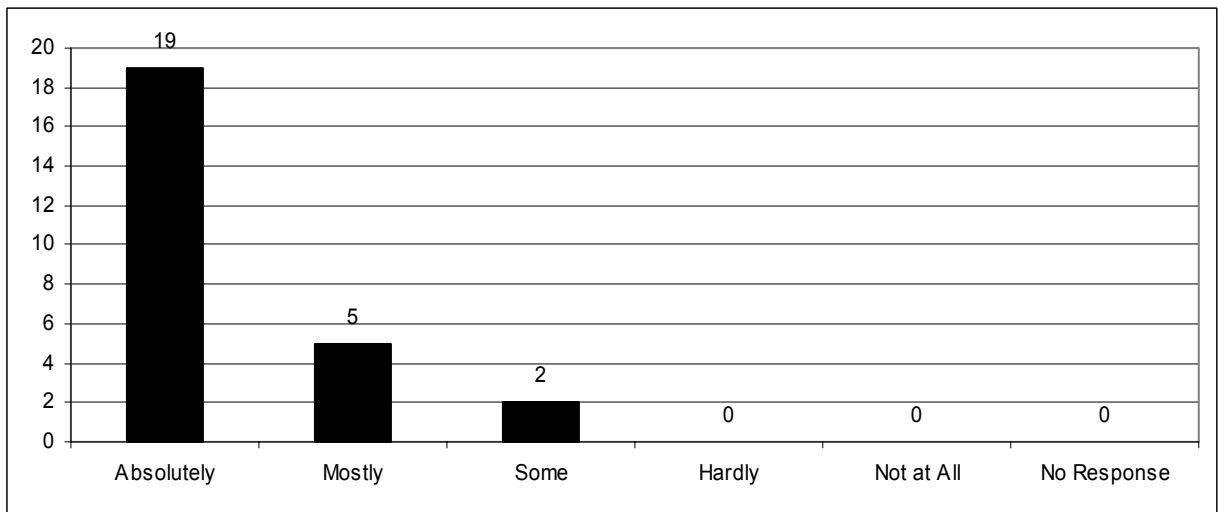

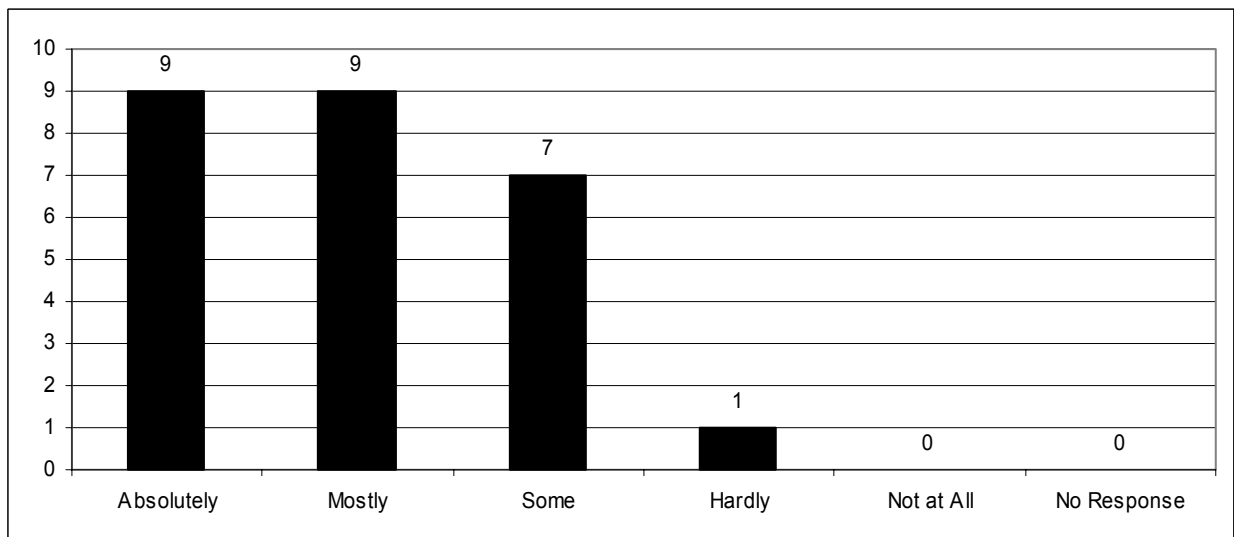

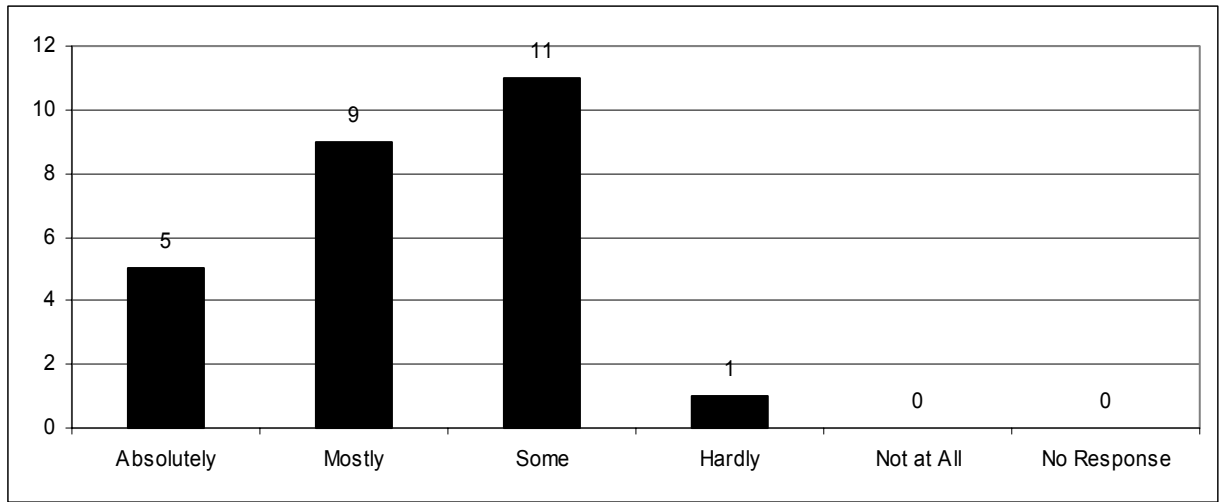
- 1. Participants will be able to describe the “dilemia” in diagnosing young child.**



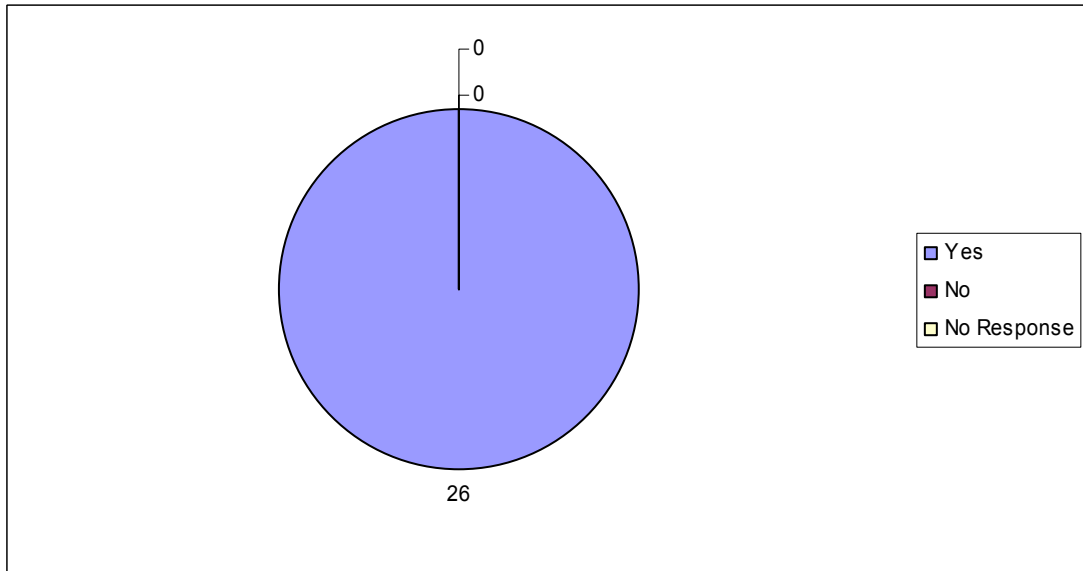
- 2. Participants will be able to articulate and understand the use of the DC: 0-3R diagnostic classification manual in the diagnosis of children.**



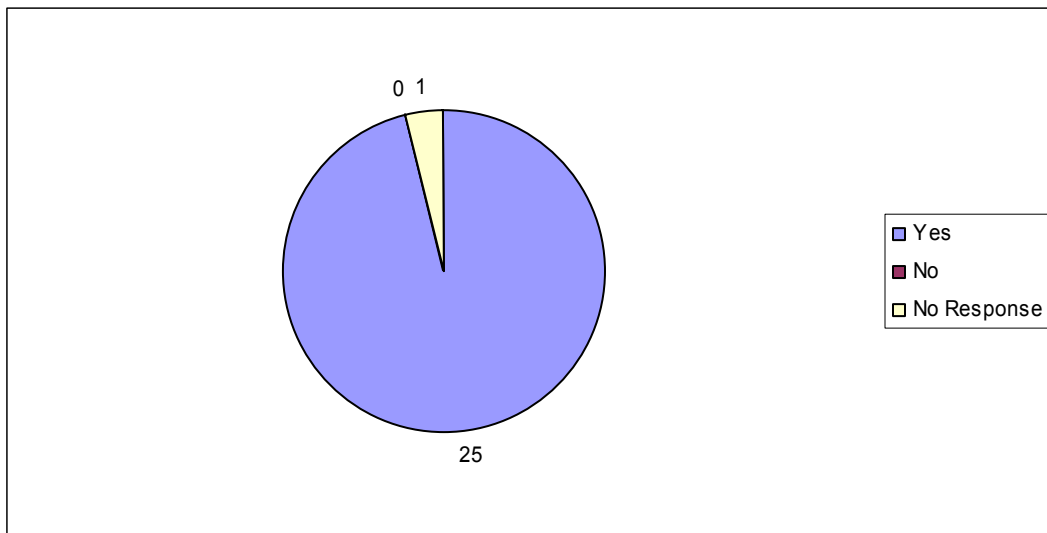
3. Participants will have discussed/determined how to differentiate those children requiring treatment/diagnosis from those at high risk of developing a mental health disorder.
