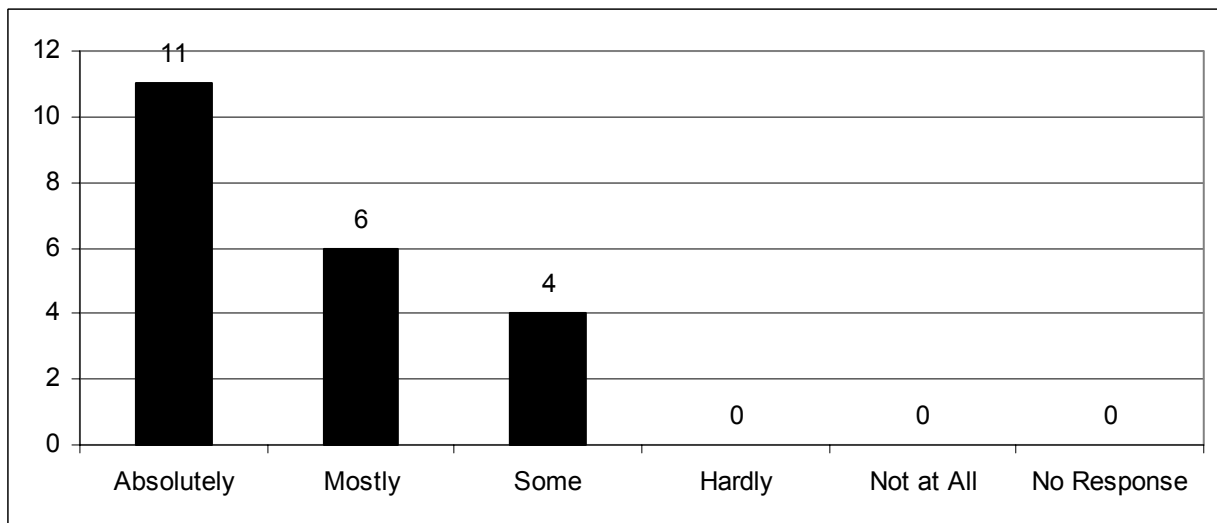

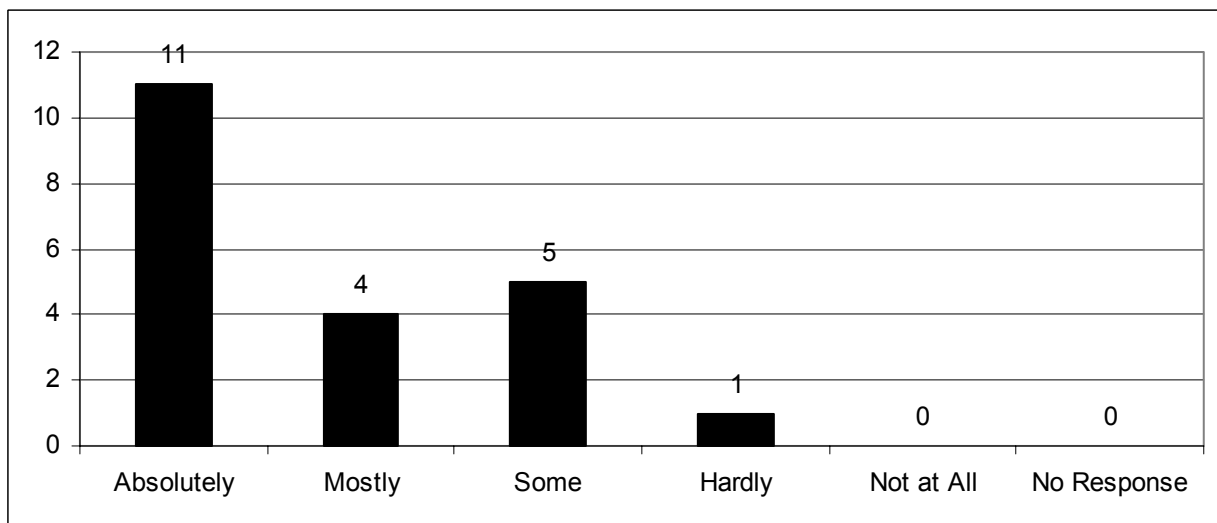
**Training Objectives:**

Participants will:

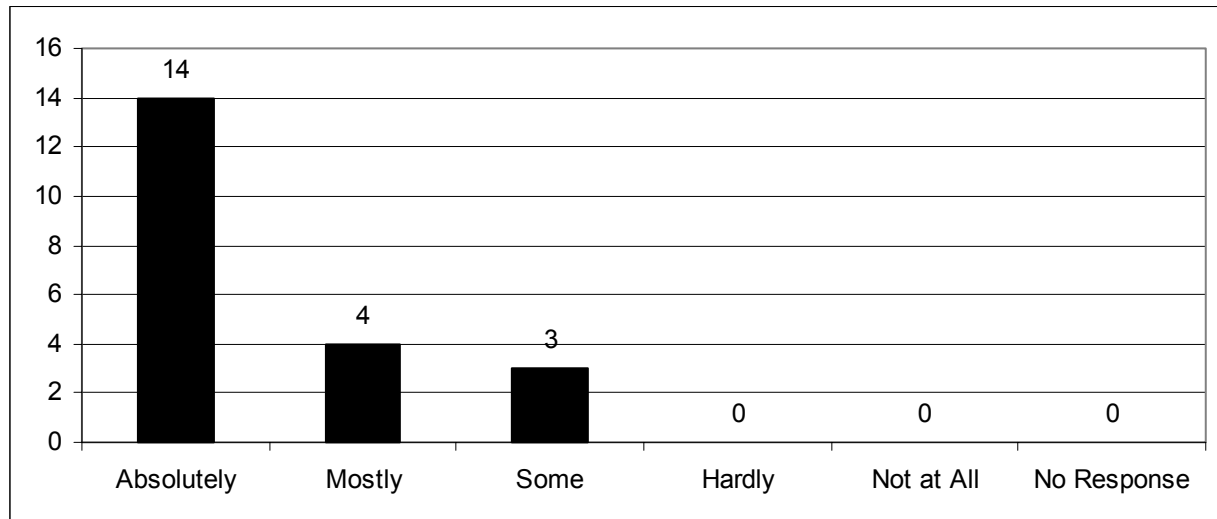
**1. Understand that PSR is clinical – dealing with mental illness and behaviors**



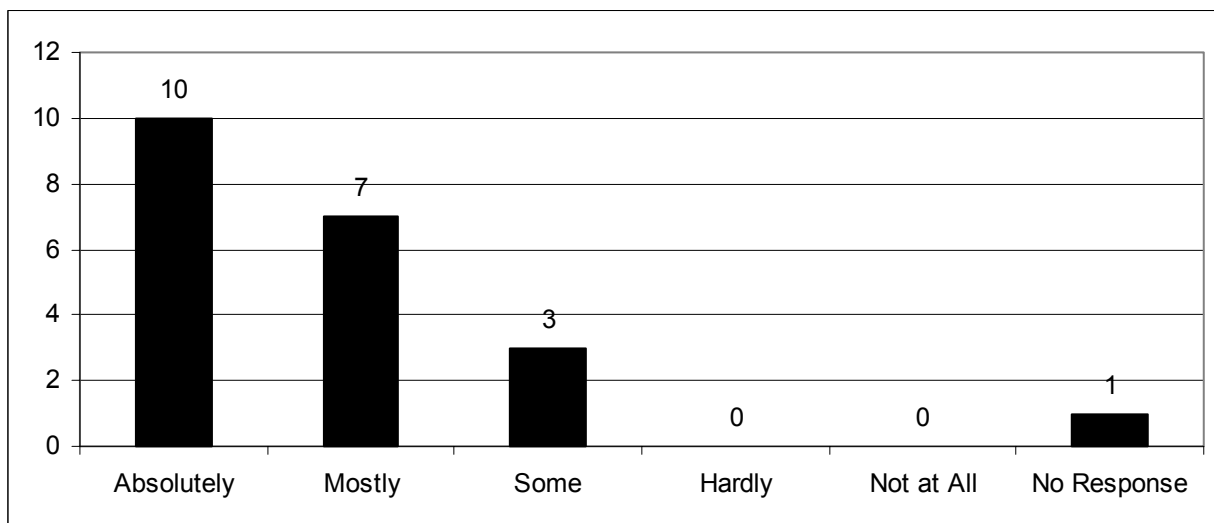
**2. Seek 2<sup>nd</sup> order change – not 1<sup>st</sup> order**



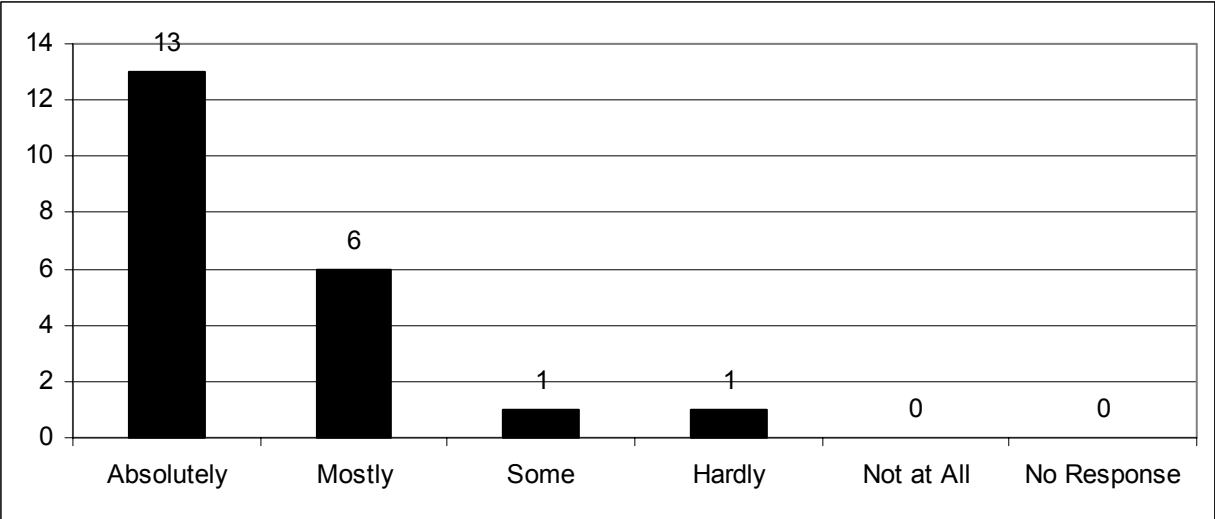
**3. Understand that parents and children must be involved for 2<sup>nd</sup> order change.**



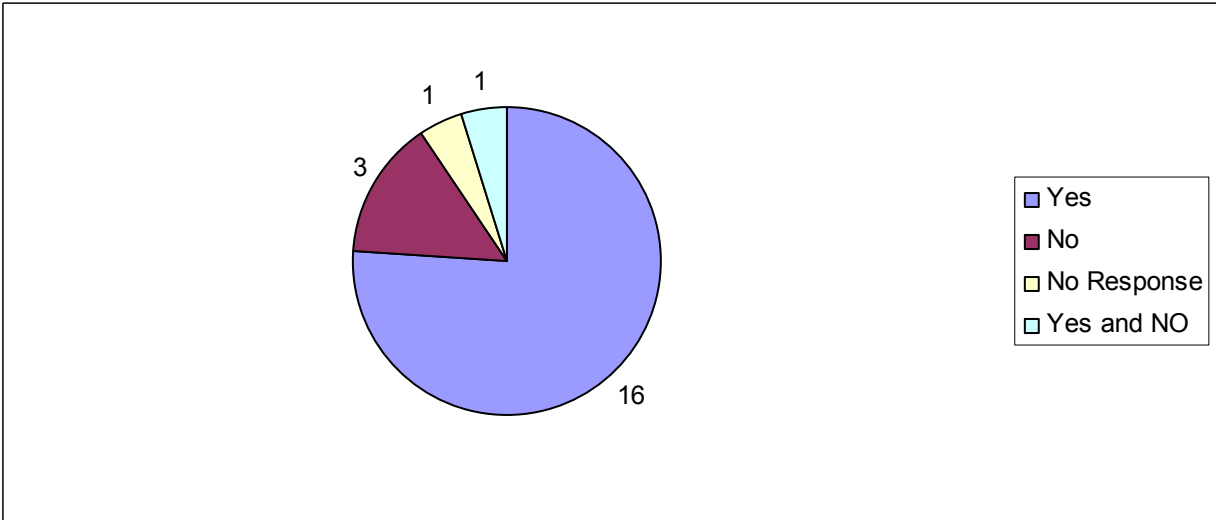
**4. Maximize PSR involvement in services – same as IOP (Intensive Outpatient Program)**



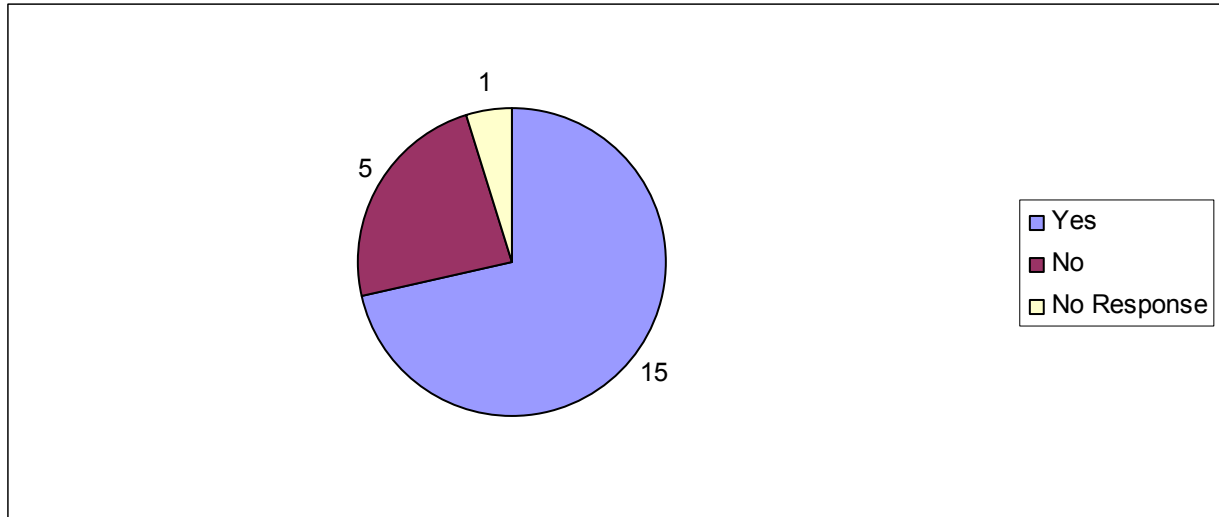
**5. Understand that individual work alone is not sufficient to produce change.**

- **That steps are being made to include family in PSR service intervention**
